Before you lies the Corona protocol 2021-2022 of N.K.S.W. Kompanio. This protocol has been written with the aim of giving the member associations, the members of members and board members a guideline on how to act in the event of symptoms or contamination from COVID-19 and any expected behavior from the member associations, the members of members and board members before, during and after activities of N.K.S.W. Kompanio. This protocol was written according to the Municipal Health Services (GGD) guidelines. Depending on the changing measures regarding COVID-19, this Corona protocol will be regularly reviewed and updated. The Corona protocol 2021-2022 can be found on the website.

1. Before activities

When a participant registers for one of the activities that N.K.S.W. Kompanio organizes, the participant will be asked for the participant's first and last name, e-mail address and phone number. The information of participants will be kept for at least 31 days. After 31 days the data will be deleted. In view of the registration for the activities that N.K.S.W. Kompanio organizes will take place in different ways, it will be explained below how this will look per type of activity (board activities, Buddyproject activities and faculty activities). When a participant agrees with the protocol, the participant declares to deregister from the activity if:

- The participant experiences symptoms that fit with COVID-19;
- The participant has been in close contact for longer than 15 minutes with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within five days prior the activity;
- The participant has been in an area designated by the government as orange or red travel advice within five days prior to the activity.

An exception can be made to the above points if the participant is protected against COVID-19 and can prove this by means of a recovery- or vaccination certificate.



Whenever a participant has to deregister for a paid activity due to the Corona protocol, the participant will get a refund if there is another participant who can fill this spot. If this is not the case, the original participant is obliged to pay.

1.1 Board activities and Buddyproject

Participants of board activities and Buddyproject activities sign up for an activity by filling in a Google Form. A link to the Corona protocol must be added in this Google Form and the participants must agree to this in order to complete the registration for the activity. For every activity of the Buddyproject a new Google Forms will be made to keep an overview of the participants.

1.2 Faculty activities

Participants of faculty activities register for an activity by buying tickets via an Eventixlink. This Eventix link will refer to the Corona protocol and they must agree to it before the registration for the activity is complete.

2. During activities

During activities, the guidelines from the National Institute for Public Health and the Environment (RIVM) must be followed at all times. For the current rules, reference is made to the website of the national government.

When a participant does not adhere to the measures drawn up during one of the activities of N.K.S.W. Kompanio, the board will hold the participant accountable and will request a change of behavior. If the participant still does not comply with the guidelines after that, the board is authorized to remove the participant from the activity. Whenever a participant does not comply with the guidelines on more than one occasion, this participant will no longer be welcome at activities of N.K.S.W. Kompanio.



3. After activities

When an activity of N.K.S.W. Kompanio is over, N.K.S.W. Kompanio can't be held responsible. If a participant experiences symptoms that fit COVID-19 within five days after the activity, the VIth board expects that this participant will be tested. If this test is positive, the participant is expected to inform the board of N.K.S.W. Kompanio by sending an email to secretary@nkswkompanio.nl. The board of N.K.S.W. Kompanio will then send an email to all participants of the activity to inform them of the contamination. The identity of the participant will remain anonymous, unless the participant gives permission to have their identity stated.
